

Greetings from Secretary

We are enthusiastic and passionate cricket lovers and players who have created Cricket Players Association of Moulvibazar UK (CPAM UK). We are all originally from a district in Bangladesh called Moulvibazar which is beautiful in nature and heritage and we take great pride in this. CPAM UK is a non-profitable organisation of British Bangladeshi cricketers who have joined together from various parts of United Kingdom.

CPAM UK emerged through a social media group called Cricket Adda created by Syed Elahi Pappu. Through this group we realised and hoped we could reunite all the cricketers who have played in Moulvibazar to play together again. On this intention our senior brothers like Murad Ahmed, Abdus Salam, Redwan Ahmed and Manjur Uddin Murshed inspired and encouraged us and Pappu, Rumel, Sayem, Tuhel, Juned, Misbah, Raju, Rasel and many others put their heart and efforts to form an organisation now known as CPAM UK.

In order to create CPAM UK we held a few meetings in London and Birmingham to take everyone's opinion. We all gathered in Birmingham on 25th of April 2016 for the inauguration of CPAM UK as an organisation. On that day we formed a convener committee where Murad Ahmed was selected as convener and Numan Ahmed Doel was selected as secretary.

We also took part in the first round of our first ever T20 tournament at Aston unity cricket club ground in Birmingham which was organised into five teams within our group. The teams were named after five of our cherished players from Bangladesh who are no longer with us. The names were JOSHIM'S FIGHTERS, BELAL'S WORRIORS, PINTU'S HITTERS, MONJU'S TROOPERS, and LITU'S SIXERS. Second round took place on 15th may 2016 at Hampstead Heath, London.

During the year 2016 we held several other events....

31st May 2016 we jointly arranged a T20 tournament with United Cricket Club Birmingham at Worcester as a farewell bid to our CPAM UK member Misbah Rashid. We finished the event with a dinner party and musical programme.

26th July 2016 we jointly arranged a T20 tournament with Portsmouth cricket club in Portsmouth. There was a musical programme held on field followed by an evening dinner party with a prize distribution for participants.

4th September 2016 we arranged a one day match in Portsmouth after the match we distributed medals and trophies to participants.



6th September 2016 we participated in a NTV Community Cup Cricket tournament. CPAM UK team were runners up at this tournament.

Apart from the tournament CPAM UK also participated in other activities such as taking part in a live program on NTV channel to promote CPAM UK and we also raised funds for a talented young cricket player in Moulvibazar Bangladesh. We also proudly sponsored Syed Mohsin Ali sriti CPAM T20 cricket tournament season 4 in Moulvibazar Bangladesh.

In year 2017 we were able to achieve 7 sport events. We also had the chance to promote CPAM UK on print and electronic media, and were fortunate enough to raise money for flood victims in Bangladesh.

2017 was also the year where we first introduced a franchise tournament. In order to create the franchise tournament we asked members to decide as to who is interested in buying a team. We finalised 5 buyers who were interested, their teams were Bombastic Bulls, Cardiff Challengers, Josh's Lions, Pitch Smashers and Rising Stars. We held a meeting on 18th April 2017 in Portsmouth to carry out a player drafting ceremony. Season 2 T20 Tournament opening ceremony was held in Cardiff on 14Th May 2017. We were grateful to the local MP Kevin Brennon Cardiff West who graced the event with his attendance. We were also thankful to

our sponsor Moshud Ahmed (President of Moulvibazar

Association Portsmouth), Ali Ahmed (Councillor of

Cardiff), Dr Bablin Mollick (Councillor of Cardiff) and all

the people of Cardiff who attended the event. It was

our first event in Cardiff and I have to mention how

much we appreciated their hospitality, special mention

to Saleh Ahmed and associates for arranging our opening ceremony for season 2. After the sports event we had a dinner party with a musical event which we all enjoyed.

Our second game of the tournament was held in Bernard's Green Worcester on 5th June 2017. As you all know an unfortunate incident took place that day with some members of CPAM UK, but Alhamdulillah they were fine and took the courage to attend the game with the same motivation and also managed to win a game. Special thanks to our Convenor Murad Ahmed who helped and managed to bring them to the game and make the event successful.

Our third game of the tournament was held at Edmonton London on 3rd July 2017. We experienced another successful game at the end of which we enjoyed a meal at Choudhry Restaurant.

Our final game of the tournament was held at St Johns College Playing Field Portsmouth on 18th July 2017. This event was graced by Lord Mayor of Portsmouth Cllr. Ken Ellcome and his wife, our sponsor Moshud Ahmed (President Organisation of Moulvibazar Portsmouth), Akhteruzzaman Quraishi Neepu (former cricketer from Moulvibazar) and the local community. The CPAM UK T20 Tournament season 2 champions were Bombastic Bulls and runners up were Rising Stars. After this successful event we attended a dinner party and presentation ceremony at Café Tusk Fareham. The presentation ceremony was also graced by Councillor Frank Jones, Tahir Ahmed BSC (Hon.) Chartered Accountant.

CPAM UK and Bristol Bangladesh Community joined

together to organise a game called Bristol Blast, this was held in Bristol on 21st August 2017. The game included 3 teams from CPAM UK registered members which were Durber, Duronto and Durjoy and 1 team from Bristol called Bristol Stars. We were really amazed with their hospitality and hope to interact with them again and arrange more games in the future.

CPAM UK also participated in London Cricket League on 6th September 2017 at Hackney Marsh London.

After our cricket season, we were still enthusiastic to take part in some sport so we organised a badminton tournament which we held in St Albans London on 13th November 2017. More than 20 teams participated in that tournament and we all had a very enjoyable day.

Other activities in 2017

On 25th April 2017 CPAM UK celebrated its first birthday, there was a small gathering held by our members to celebrate this day at short notice.

On 8th May 2017 we organised a meeting with the print and electronic media called meet the Press. We were able to present CPAM UK expressing what we have managed to achieve so far and what we hope to do in the future. It was very much appreciated by the media journalists, and they have shown interest in working with us in the future and have invited us to arrange a friendly match between CPAM UK and London Bangla Press Club.

On 2nd August 2017 CPAM UK were invited to attend a live programme on TV1. We were able to put forward our achievements, details of our tournaments and our future goals to a wide community via this show.

In January 2018 we held our annual general meeting where we formed CPAM UK's Advisory panel and full general committee. The advisory panel consists of seven advisors and Murad Ahmed as chief advisor. The general committee includes twenty one members with Abdus Salam as the President and Numan Ahmed Doel as General Secretary.

During the year 2018 we have been able to achieve 7 sport events, and few other social events. We also had the chance to promote CPAM UK on print and electronic media. As a gesture of goodwill we Sponsored CPAM Shadar's main tournament in Moulvibazar and were fortunate enough to raise money for flood victims in Moulvibazar Bangladesh again.

In our last annual meeting we discussed about how we can improve and better CPAM UK season 3. At the time we took a decision to introduce a CPAM UK into other external community tournaments which was

proposed by general members and also renew the new membership. Year 2018 we had 99 registered members

In order to create the franchise tournament we asked members to decide as to who is interested in buying a team. We finalised 7 buyers who were interested, their teams were Bengal Tigers , Cardiff Challengers, Josh's Lions, Kings Of Cpam Uk, Moulvibazar Legends, United Knights, and Unbeaten Eleven We held a meeting on 10th April 2018 in Birmingham to carry out a player drafting ceremony.

Season 3 T20 Tournament opening ceremony was held in London on 8Th May 2018. Syed Joynu our main sponsor, Abdus Samad our co-sponsor, former cricketer from Moulvibazar Najrul Islam, former BCB coach Saidul Alam Ratan, Jawar Ali and Shamim Ahmed attended the event. It was our first sports event in 2018.

Our second game of the tournament was held in Cardiff on 24th June 2018.

Our third game of the tournament was held in Portsmouth on 4th July 2018.

Our fourth game of the tournament was held in Birmingham on 17th July 2018.

Our Fifth game of the tournament was held in Bristol on 1st August 2018.

Our Sixth and final event of the franchise tournament was held in London on 14th August 2018. The winners of the tournament were Josh's Lion and Unbeaten Eleven were the runners up.

After our Franchise tournament, we were still enthusiastic to play more Cricket so we took part in a friendly one day cricket match with CPAM UK members in London on 10th September.

Other activities:

CPAM UK was invited to attend a live programme on NTV. We were able to put forward our achievements, details of our tournaments and our future goals to a wide community via this show.

CPAM UK participated in London Cricket League at Hackney Marsh London.

During the holy month of Ramadan CPAM UK held an Iftar party in Portsmouth where many of the community leaders were present.

We were able to raise money from our social liability for flood victims in Moulvibazar Bangladesh it was distributed by our CPAM Shadar members. I would like to thank CPAM shadar in helping to distribute the relief.

With great sadness we were informed of the sudden loss of our fellow CPAM UK member and one of our

founder members Sahan ahmed at the age of 35 years. He will be missed and our prayers and good wishes are with his family. May Allah SWT grant him Jannatul Ferdaus.

To celebrate the end of season 3 we held our first Gala dinner with prize distribution ceremony which was attended many prestigious guests like local MP, Mayor, Councillors, and many other well-known Entrepreneurs and businessmen. They all highly appreciated and praised CPAM UK and our efforts and contribution in cricket in the Bangladeshi community. In this ceremony we provided life time achievement awards for two of our eldest cricketers who were the original founders and cricket players of Moulvibazar, Mr Nazrul Islam and Mr Zakir Hussain. Through this event we raised money to support and show our gratitude to our beloved legendary cricketer and umpire Bulbul Islam. He has been an inspiration for all of us cricketers who have played cricket in Moulvibazar. We cannot express his love for cricket and his guidance toward us. His early departure from this world has been a shock for all of

us, he will be dearly missed. May Allah SWT grant him the highest rank in Jannah.

The year 2019 has been a special year for CPAM UK. We had a great season 4 and to top it up we experienced the cricket world cup 2019 in UK with our beloved Bangladesh Team playing and our England team winning. In order to franchise tournament season 4 we finalised six teams this year

they were Josh's Lions, RK Challengers, Moulvibazar Legends, Birmingham Titans, Cardiff Challengers and Unbeaten Eleven CPAM UK.

Our sponsors this year are Mr Syed Joynu, Mr Iqbal Miah, Mr Syedur Rahman Ranu and Mr Abul kalam. Our Players drafting took place in Birmingham.

This year we were unfortunate with the weather for which we had to cancel our first two events.

On Tuesday 9th July we managed to begin our first game for the season in Cheltenham. It was hosted by Aklasul Momin. It was CPAM UK's first ever game in Cheltenham which we thoroughly enjoyed.

Tuesday 16th July our second event took place in London Hackney Marsh and Edmonton cricket club ground.

Greetings from Chief Advisor






Primary incentive of this organisation is to work with ex-Cricketers within Uk and help support develop Cricket in Moulvibazar, Bangladesh.






