ricket Players Association of Moulvibazar is an alliance of British Bangladeshi cricketers, known as CPAM UK.

It is an absolute pleasure to be part of such an enthralling organisation. I am amazed by outpouring of love, mutual respect, the brotherhood and the passion for cricket all of which are instantly felt when engaged with our members. As we continue to adhere to our slogan "passion brings us together" we continue to thrive and each year achieve new heights.

CPAM UK has given us a platform to mingle and at the same time an opportunity to catch up those missing years as some of us had left Moulvibazar much earlier than the others. Being associated with our members I feel rejuvenated. I witness the same in cricketers of my generation who I also played with in Moulvibazar in my youth and subsequently here in the UK.

I am proud to say, we are unique in many ways; we are probably the only association in the UK to facilitate internal franchise tournament which not only attract our members but also sponsors

and other cricket clubs. We are mostly amateur cricketers, many of us surpassed our cricketing peak in Bangladesh yet some amongst us still play league cricket and our emerging young cricketers continue to progress through the ranks. I sincerely hope that one day some of these youngsters will break into counties and represent England.

Our activities began in 2015 but we did not form Committee or held cricketing events until in the spring of 2016. We followed the model of CPAM Sadar set up in Moulvibazar in 2007. While they concentrate on their activities in and around the region, our activities span across the UK and beyond. Our members often travel hundreds of miles to attend events; sacrifice day-offs and precious family time to fulfil commitments. We therefore



felt the need to expand our horizon to make us more accessible hence we continue to utilise our contacts and each year we add new venues and enrol new members.

We feel strongly about our root too. We understand how important it is to support the development of cricket and the community. Moulvibazar has a rich cricketing heritage and we are so very proud of this. We regularly produce excellent cricketers, some went onto become full internationals for Bangladesh. We would like to see this trend continue hence we sponsor at least one tournament every year and nurture young talents to reach their full potential. We also support our communities when there is a need; reaching out to the flood victims and those affected by the Covid-19 pandemic are some of the examples of our good works outside cricket.

We are a resilient bunch; our activities of past two seasons bear all the hallmarks. While the international community were down with the impact of Covid-19, we regrouped ourselves soon after the lockdown measures were eased. We successfully completed seasons with franchise tournaments and day events under exceptional circumstances. Furthermore, we value the contributions of our forefathers who set up a cricketing platform for us and showed us the way forward. Without their guidance, to develop further and bring the cricket of Moulvibazar to the level where they are today would have been unimaginable. We therefore started to highlight their cricketing






