It brings me great joy to announce that the 2022 season 7 was our most successful season so far. All the events and other activities from the previous season 1-6 were completed properly and by the grace of Allah. Our journey started in 2015 with the slogan “passion brings us together” and it has been a tremendously rewarding journey full of great memories and joy. CPAM UK is a dream that has grown into such a great platform and a big cohesive committee. Due to everyone's hard work, dedication and commitment, our committee is so successful today. Alhamdulillah we completed a total of 10 events in this Season 7, 2022. The first physical meeting after the formation of the full committee was held on January 2022 in London. Syed Joynu was our main sponsor of season 4 & 5, who sadly left us from this world in Oct 2021.

We followed this by organising the player draft event and announcing the franchise teams on 29th March 2022. On the eve of our players draft we held a Virtual talk-show discussing our Season-7 Franchise Tournament preparation. This always gives us an opportunity to announce our plans and engage members and wider audience. In Ramadan, we organized an Iftar party to celebrate our 7th anniversary which has firmly taken its place in our annual calendar.

On the 31st May, the much anticipated Grand Opening of our Franchise Tournament was held in South London. Mohammad Ashraful, former captain of Bangladesh National Cricket Team, was present at this event along with our main Sponsor of Season-7, Ashraf Choudhury, CEO Kutchenhaus, High Wycombe. We held our second event on 14th June, followed by third event on 26th June, fourth event on 5th July and 5th event on 13th July at venues across London and home-counties. Our Final Event of the Franchise Tournament took place on 2nd August at Kings House, Chiswick, West London. A venue which has accustomed to CPAM UK members as the most popular venue for the location and facilities it provides.

The month of August is usually a time for family holidays but some team members were



still available so we took the opportunity to organise another event. We held 'JD Trophy' (Joshim Daniel Trophy) in memory of two of our very own legends from the town. Late Joshim Ahmed was an admirable figure in the cricketing community while Syed Munir Daniel was a teacher (known as Daniel Sir) who was heavily involved in cricket and was the first manager of Moulvibazar District Cricket Team which took part in nation championship in 1990. Both of them made significant contributions in the development of cricket, sports and culture so we are proud to have held a tournament in their memory. In this tournament it was also first time we invited two teams, outside of CPAM, from Portsmouth and Hull through our members' connection.

We have continued to sponsor cricket tournaments and earlier this year we formalised sponsorship to district-level under-sixteen team in Moulvibazar, Bangladesh. This year, we have also produced a theme song for CPAM UK which is widely played in our events. We also presented our logo embossed Polo T-shirts to all our members for registering with us. In early September, we ended this season by hosting a trendy '100 ball cricket tournament' in Newport.
