How cricket in our community excelled through common passion for the game

Many of us began our journey as young cricketers in the neighbourhoods, in the subdivisional town of Moulvibazar. We grew up watching our older generations play; amongst them were siblings, friends and even uncles and this trend continued with our younger generation waiting in the wings for their opportunities. These were the main pathways for ambitious youngsters wishing to enter club cricket. I am talking about the years of 1980's and 1990's and fast forward many decades, things are now very different.

A new dawn cracked open in April 1997, when Bangladesh won the ICC Trophy in Malaysia. In the subsequent years, cricket spread like a wildfire. A game until that time was only being played in and around towns became incredibly popular even in rural villages. Our District Sports Association started hosting multi-tier cricket league and alongside club organisers held tournaments to accommodate all these enthusiasts and their teams. A few cricket academies were also set up through private initiatives that quickly flourished, facilitating quality coaching, all of which provided a perfect foundation for nurturing young talents. Over time, our district team made a significant name for itself in our national cricketing map, winning multiple regional and divisional championships in various age groups. In this process, we produced cricketers of the highest quality and fed a good few into the national side, swing master Ebadot Hussain being amongst those great achievers to date.

I missed those late years, as by then, I had left the town. It was in the summer of 1992 when I moved to the UK to join my family. I was young, energetic and still fresh from representing our first ever senior district team that participated in the national championship in Chandpur. I always had strong social connections from a young age and soon after my arrival, I was itching for some game-time. My cricket buddy, a year senior in the high school, Abdus Salam (Salam bhai) was already living in the UK. After learning of my arrival, he called me one evening and we caught up.

It wasn't long before he picked me up one Sunday afternoon and drove me to the south of the river. There he introduced me to Abdul Qadir Badsha of Abahani Cricket Club. Late Badsha bhai was a very successful entrepreneur, who went on to become a public figure, serving as a Councillor and then Deputy Mayor for Croydon. He was a great advocate for the game, a well-known patron who provided opportunities including lodging to many emerging cricketers from the subcontinent. Our former test captain Aminul Islam Bulbul and Indian wicket-keeper Nayan Mongia were amongst a few renowned cricketers who played for Abahani CC early in their careers. I thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to participate and rub shoulders with some top-level cricketers. We finished the Slazenger league as champions in that division in Surrey. I vividly remember attending my first award ceremony one evening at the end of that summer. I am ever so grateful to both Badsha bhai and Salam bhai for taking me through this journey. Following year, I joined Paddington College Cricket Club through my local connections. In PCCC we also had players from many nationalities but mainly Guyanese. I played with them for a few years in the North Middlesex league. By then a few more fellow cricketers started arriving from Bangladesh to settle in the UK. It was around that time, through my work in Camden, I met a community worker called Victoria. Her role was to facilitate activities for the community and particularly keep the young people engaged. One day she proposed "why don't we play a weekend game of cricket between England v Bangladesh?" I quickly jumped on her idea because it was at a time when racial tensions were running high, particularly after some youth troubles in the area, and it fitted in perfectly for the purpose of improving social cohesion and somewhat heal a fractured community.

In that first match in July 1997, I invited a few friends and family; amongst them were Zafor (Syed Zafor), Apu (Mohi Uddin), Suhel (Tariqur Rahman), Bappy mama (Gulam Tanvir), Salam bhai (Abdus Salam), my nephew Mizan (Mizan Khan) and a few other local boys from around Kings Cross and Euston areas. It was hard to manage a full team for the weekends as people had work and family commitments and someone would often pull out in the last minute. While I was still playing in the league, we had a few of those matches each year until 1999, then Victoria moved up north of England. In the summer of 2000, we held our first reunion for cricketers from Moulvibazar. This was truly a joyous occasion and first-time in many years it felt like we were back playing again either in government school grounds or the college stadium. The event was held in the

enclosure at Parliament Hill Fields, North London and the following cricketers were involved; Masud Chowdhury, Late Morshed Chowdhury, Redwan Ahmed, Tofayel Siddiqui, Tariqur Rahman Suhel, Nizam Ahmed, Abdus Salam, Mizan Khan, Shahed Yunus, Mohi Uddin Apu, Ahmedur Rahman Amin, Humayun Kabir Ripon, Shahir Khan, Shamim Rahman, Syed Zafor, Sadique Ahmed Chowdhury, Suhel Siddiqui, Mujibur Rahman Lakhon, Late Saleh Mousuf, Nizam Chowdhury, Muhibur Rahman Malon and Pushpo Deb. Our event was well attended, we split into two teams 'red' and 'green' the colours in honour of our national flag. Senior cricketer Nazrul bhai (Late Nazrul Islam) attended the event as our chief guest, who spent the whole day umpiring along with Pushpo Da (Pushpo Deb) and then handing out trophies and medals to winners and all participants. That successful event led us to a new beginning, the birth of Moulvibazar Cricket Club (MCC), UK. We had many more friends who joined us the following year, namely M Motlib Siddiqui Shaheen, Ehsan Haque Sumon, Nazmul Islam Biplob and others. Having Shaheen joined us as our team manager meant we could concentrate on playing and not worrying about booking pitches, sorting out lunch and refreshments, paying invoices and so on. Shaheen earned a massive accolade for his hard work and subsequent development and introduction of the cricket scoring app nXCricket that was endorsed by the ECB and then being used globally. In 2020, during Covid-19 period MCC-UK celebrated its 20th anniversary in Hampstead Heath, London whereby money raised were donated to fund establish an ICU Unit in Moulvibazar Sadar Hospital. I truly believe, that event in 2000 also encouraged friends from Portsmouth to organise themselves, and in 2001 we had our first tour playing against Portsmouth Moulvibazar Cricket Club (PMCC). It wasn't easy, as there weren't enough players from a particular region, to make a team of eleven but Redwan bhai and Nizam's effort certainly paid off with strong commitments from their teammates Shohid bhai (Abdus Shohid), Saif bhai, Khukon, Belal, Joshim, Juber, Ahad, Raju, Shabbir, Foyso and others.

Portsmouth is a city with high concentration of people from Moulvibazar and it always felt like home to many of us. For next few years we would tour a few times during the summer and we had Dada (Syed Shajaman Ahmed), Moshud bhai (Moshud Ahmed), our friend Suyeb (Abu-Suyeb Tanzam), Boku bahi, Sacchu bhai, Saliq bhai, Bablu and others who would always come to the ground to support us and would bring snacks and drinks including tea in big flasks as if it was their duty treat us. None of us can ever repay for their kindness, love and hospitality.

In the same year, we had found out about another team from Shoreham and Brighton areas of West Sussex and it wasn't long before MCC UK and PMCC were holding matches against them in their venues as well as inviting them back to venues in and around London. We are also grateful to Muhit bhai, Shahin and others for their support and hospitality.

In the subsequent years, my good friend and work colleague Ian Walker invited MCC UK and we started playing his team, St Peter's Church, in Sidcup, Bexley and other venues around Kent which we continued for some years. By then our network had expanded further and we had more players in the likes of Faisal Quiyum, Shumon Sharif, Abu Zubair, Rashu Ahmed, Ebak Ahmed, Abu Nasser, Indrajeet, Maksood Chaiwala, Murad Ahmed, Rahat Islam and many more joined us and we started visiting more new locations. Our connection with Brighton grew stronger after Mubin bhai (Jawad Chowdhury) settled there and invited us to take part in a short format day tournament.

In 2010, at this event, we came to know for the first time about the MCCL (Moulvibazar Cricket Club, London). We spoke to Abdul Alim Shipon who explained the naming and that their operation would be London based. Shipon along with his friends Bodrul (Bodrul Alam) and Rahat (Rahat Quadir) set up MCCL. They play in the NCL (National Cricket League) around East London and over the years made some significant progress winning the league and securing promotions that attracted a new generation of young cricketers.

Meanwhile, in West of England, Bristol Bangladesh Cricket Club (BBCC) was formed in 2004 and the following year they officially began competing in their local league. Their club captain Ashfaq ur Rahman Kibriya was a founding figure and was already part of the Gloucestershire youth set up, who also played for Bristol West Indies. He had Syed Saeed Ahmed and Aminul Islam both of whom ably supported him over the years. Mufly Ahmed Ripon and his younger brother Tufayel Ahmed Tuhin were also closely connected. With them joined Salahuddin Ahmed (Shobuj) as a youngster, with BKSP background who rapidly grew through the ranks. Under his leadership BBCC won the 2025 North Somerset Cricket League. Further west in Cardiff, Wales, approximately in 2003/2004 'Shadhinota Cup' was organised by Mustafa Saleh Liton where others involved were Munim Khan Bablu, Saiful Islam Shipu, Ferdaus Rahman, Imdadur Rahman Russell and others. Some of them were behind forming Bengal Tigers which played mid-week league in South Wales. Subsequently, Cardiff Untied CC were established where Taj Ahmed and Abdul Ahmed were key contributors.

Our cricketers and organizers were very active across the United Kingdom, and likewise, in West Midlands, Blue Magpie Cricket Club was set up in 2011. Players included Syed Karim Rumel, LR Choudhury Raju, who both represented Moulvibazar district team. They also had Humayun Ahmed, Misba Ahmed, Monjur Hussain and Tanvir Ahmed Saad.

Many more players from Bangladesh joined over the years and as the demand rose, Birmingham United Cricket Club was formed in 2013 and players included were Najmus Sakib, Reza, Imran Hussain, Aklasul Momin and others.

There are many more stories of small community groups and close circle of friends who either played club cricket in their localities or helped set up their own clubs with native people who they played with in their youth. Many of these small groups, circle of friends and their clubs from UK towns and regions formed by cricketers of many generations hugely contributed in unifying everyone under one umbrella in 2015 and that is the CPAM UK of today.



CPAM-UK City Cup Becomes One of the Fastest-Growing Cricket Tournaments in the UK Ethnic Minority Community To broaden participation beyond its own membership, CPAM-UK launched the City Cup Cricket



Tournament in 2024, bringing together cricket clubs from across the country. The inaugural edition featured twelve teams: Manchester Chadderton, Hull Bengal Tigers, Birmingham Warriors, Midland Tigers, Wolver-



hampton Challengers, Walsall United, Portsmouth Elites, Hampshire Risers, Cardiff Dragons, East London MCCI, North London Tottenham, and Essex Neo. Essex Neo claimed the championship title after defeating Manchester Chad-



derton in a thrilling final. Former Bangladesh national team player Sowravdi Shuvo delivered a standout performance with an unbeaten century. The tournament quickly established itself as the largest cricket competition within the UK's ethnic minority community, earning widespread recognition for its strong organisation and competitive quality.

The overwhelming success of the first edition led to 27 teams applying for participation in the City Cup. Due to limited ground availability and the need to maintain a manageable tournament



structure, only twelve teams could be selected. The 2025 lineup included: Manchester Chadderton, Oldham OKR, Birmingham Bengal Tigers, Gloucester Gladiators, Bristol City Cricket Club, Welsh Dragons, Luton Fast Lion, East London Mighty Tigers, West London ABM, North London United, and London Riders. A remarkable 26 current and former Bangladeshi national cricket-



ers represented various teams throughout the tournament. The 2025 edition concluded with a nail-biting final in which North London United secured the championship after overcoming West London ABM. The level of community engagement and support surpassed all expectations. The City Cup has rapidly evolved into a signature event and a symbol of pride within the Bangladeshi community in the UK. The CPAM-UK Management Committee reaffirms its commitment to delivering the City Cup annually and aims to make the tournament even more glamorous and impactful in the years ahead.



